1. Pending the Resolution of DEMOCRATIC PARTY OF THE PHILIPPINES' December 7, 2009 Motion for Reconsideration on the DISMISSAL of its Petition for Registration (SPP No. 09-020), its status as a Registered Political Party is yet to be determined.

2. Among the persons who filed their certificate of candidacy for president as independent candidates are the following:

a. JAMBY AS. MADRIGAL - an incumbent Senator of the Republic. While she ran as independent candidate, her political track record in launching a serious nationwide campaign is unquestionable, proven by her in the election in the senate. It can therefore be concluded that aside from having bona fide intentions of running for the position of president, they are possessed with sufficient political manpower, resources and machinery to launch a nationwide campaign.

b. MARIO B. CRESPO - Also known as "Mark 'Mj' Jimenez", a former Member of the House of Representatives in the City of Manila who was figured in an extradition case in the United States. Despite this, however, Mr. Crespo has no proven political track record in nationwide candidacy; more so in this election, wherein he does not have any political party affiliation to support his bid for the presidency. It would be quite difficult for one man, independent at that, to seriously mount a presidential campaign throughout the nation.

- c. **LIZA L. MAZA** - an incumbent Member of the House of Representatives in the Party-List System of Representation under the **GABRIELA** Party-List, who had also already launched a successful national campaign in support of her party-list organization.

It can therefore be concluded that aside from having bona fide intentions of running for the position of senator, all of these candidates are possessed with sufficient political manpower, resources and machinery to launch a nationwide campaign.

Records show that many of the person who filed their certificates of candidacy as independent candidates for the May 10, 2010 Automated National and Local Elections had previously filed their certificates of candidacy for the position of either the president, vice-president or senator during the past elections, but were **DENIED DUE COURSE** and/or **CANCELLED** by the Commission. Even those persons who were allowed to run for elections garnered votes which are too few and menger to consider their candidacy as serious. Most are considered habitual filers as evidenced by the filing of their certificates of candidacy in almost every national election despite the denial thereof, time and time again, to wit:

Aside from these perennial filers, whose certificates of candidacy were denied due course and otherwise had been declared as nuisance candidates, a careful examination of their certificates of candidacy, including several from independent candidates not included above, showed on its face entries that would easily lead to conclusion that said certificates were prepared by persons of unsound and unstable mind

It is observed similarly that there were indications that some certificates of candidacy were merely filed to put the election process in mockery; the persons doing so do not have the bona fide intention of running for the position for which they filed their certificates of candidacy for; the persons doing so not having proved the capacity and capability to mount a serious and bona fide nationwide campaign to support their bid to public office. If said certificates of candidacy were to be approved, such consideration would only prevent a faithful and proper determination of the will of the electorate and ultimately frustrate the sanctity of the electoral process.

PHILIPPINE GREEN REPUBLICAN PARTY, although allowed to participate in the May 14, 2007 National and Local Elections, fielded only one candidate, FELIX C. CANTAL, who lost his bid for the position of senator. Additionally, several members of its senatorial slate are considered by the Commission as perennial applicants whose certificates of candidacy were denied due course: AMADO C. COMBATE and MELCHOR G. CHAVEZ. Moreover, PHILIPPINE GREEN REPUBLICAN PARTY has yet to establish its political track record, capacity and capability to launch a campaign on the national level.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

Section 2 and 3 of Article VII of the 1987 Constitution of the Republic of Philippines read:

"Sec. 2. No person may be elected President unless he is a natural-born citizen of the Philippines, a registered voter, able to read and write, at least forty years of age on the day of the election, and a resident of the Philippines for at least ten years immediately preceding such election.

Sec. 3. There shall be a Vice-President who shall have the same qualifications and term of office and be elected with and in the same manner as the President. x x x x x x x x x."

Likewise, Section 3 of Article VI thereof provides:

"No person shall be a Senator unless he is a natural born citizen of the Philippines, and on the day of the election, is at least thirty-five years of age, able to read and write a registered voter, and a resident of the Philippines for not less than two years immediately preceding the day of the election."

Aside from one (1) presidential aspirant, all other candidates have met the constitutionally mandated requirements. Mr. RODELO SUYOM PIDOY lacks the necessary age qualification for candidacy for the position of president²⁶ with him having been born only on March 8, 1984²⁷, and would just be twenty-six (26) years of age on the day of the election; hence his disqualification.

On the other hand, despite having possessed the requirements provided under law, the candidates' capacity to wage a national campaign and the determination of their true intent in filing the certificates of candidacy is another matter.

The Constitution provides that the State shall guarantee equal access to opportunities for public office; this privilege is subject however, to limitations. Section 69 of the Omnibus Election Code as amended by Section 5 of R.A. 6646²⁸, gave this Commission the power to motu proprio cancel or deny due course to a certificate of candidacy of registered candidates. It provides, that:

"Nuisance candidates. - The Commission may, motu proprio or upon a verified petition of an interested party, refuses to give due course to or cancel a certificate of candidacy if it shown that said certificate has been filed to put the election process in mockery or disrepute or to cause confusion among the voters by the similarity of the names of the registered candidates or by other circumstances or acts which clearly demonstrate that the candidate has no bona fide intention to run for the office for which the certificate of candidacy has been filed and thus prevent a faithful determination of the true will of the electorate."

A nuisance candidate therefore is one whose certificate of candidacy is presented and filed to cause confusion among the electorate by the similarity of names of the registered candidate or by other names which demonstrate that the candidate has no bona fide intention to run for the office for which the certificate of candidacy has been filed and thus prevent a faithful determination of the will of the electorate.²⁹

More recently in the case of Pamatong vs. COMELEC³⁰, the Supreme Court said that "the rationale behind the prohibition against nuisance candidates and the disqualification of candidates who have not evinced a bona fide intention to run for office is easy to divine. The State has a compelling interest to ensure that its electoral exercises are rational, objective, and orderly. Towards this end, the state takes into account the practical considerations in conducting elections. Inevitably, the greater the number of candidates, the greater the opportunities for logistical confusion, not to mention the increased allocation of time and resources in preparation for the election. These practical difficulties should, of course, never exempt the State from the conduct of a mandated electoral exercise. At the same time, remedial actions should be available to alleviate these logistical hardships, whenever necessary and proper."

Taking all these into account, the Commission has the sole mandate to administer election laws and conduct elections; and with it is bestowed considerable latitude to adopt rules and regulations that will ensure orderly elections.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the Law Department hereby RECOMMENDS as follows:

I. TO CANCEL/DENY DUE COURSE to the certificates of candidacy for president of the following persons:
