10 MARCH 2010

(16) G.R. No. 186594 (Jose Miguel T. Arroyo vs. Niñez Castro Olivares, et al.).- The Court resolves:

- (1) to *GRANT* petitioner's first and second motions for extension totaling seventeen (17) days from 14 January 2010 within which to file a reply to comment on the petition for review on certiorari; and
- (2) to *NOTE* the said reply thereafter filed.

Considering the allegations, issues, and arguments adduced in the petition for review on certiorari with prayer for the issuance of preliminary injunction and/or temporary restraining order of the Decision and Resolution dated 22 September 2008 and 24 February 2009, respectively, of the Court of Appeals in CA GR SP No. 99025, the Court further resolves to *DENY* the petition for failure of petitioner to sufficiently show that the Court of Appeals committed any reversible error in the challenged decision and resolution as to warrant the exercise of this Court's discretionary appellate jurisdiction.
